

Social Media Policy

BWI recognizes the value of social media as a powerful tool to raise awareness and support for our work. We also recognize the importance of protecting vulnerable communities from any form of exploitation. BWI has a stringent social media policy and requires that our volunteers adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Volunteers **MUST** first get permission from Volunteer Team Leader before taking photos/videos.

2. Volunteers may **NOT** post photos and videos of faces of the children. If a child's face is in a photo you wish to post, please use an emoji or an app to blur the faces of the children.

3. All media originally posted on BWI social media sites is available for volunteers to use as a means for fundraising & awareness on their personal accounts, as BWI already has permission for this media.

4. Any idea or project using filming or photography must first get written approval from the Volunteer Team Leader.
